

Where to plug in the switch

Article Overview

For a Nintendo Switch, plug in the power adapter and optionally HDMI to a TV; for a network switch, plug in your devices via Ethernet ports and PoE devices if needed.

Nintendo Switch Setup

- o **Power Adapter:** Use the official Nintendo Switch USB-C power adapter. Plug one end into the wall outlet and the other into the Switch console or the dock's AC Adapter port .
- o **HDMI Cable:** If connecting to a TV, plug one end of an HDMI cable into the dock's HDMI Out port and the other into your TV .
- o **Docking the Console:** Place the Switch into the dock to charge and display on the TV. The dock has a USB-C port for power and an HDMI port for video output .
- o **Optional Accessories:** You can connect controllers, a Pro Controller, or other peripherals to the dock's USB-A port for charging or pairing .

You can also charge the Switch directly via USB-C without the dock, but HDMI output to a TV requires the dock or a compatible USB-C hub with HDMI .

Network Switch Setup

- o **Ethernet Devices:** Plug computers, printers, servers, or other network devices into the switch's Ethernet ports. Each port allows data transfer between devices within the LAN .
- o **High-Bandwidth Devices:** Connect servers or NAS devices to Gigabit Ethernet ports to maximize speed and prevent bottlenecks .
- o **PoE Devices:** If your switch supports Power over Ethernet, plug in devices like IP cameras, wireless access points, or VoIP phones to receive both power and data from the switch .
- o **Port Organization:** For managed switches, consider using VLAN-capable ports to segregate network segments for security and efficiency .

By following these steps, you ensure that your Nintendo Switch or network switch is properly powered, connected, and ready for use.
