

Which fiber optic cable does the Xiaomi router connect to

Fiber Compatibility

Cable Requirements

To connect a Xiaomi router to a fiber internet service, the typical setup involves:

- o Fiber optic cable from the wall outlet to the ONT - This cable is usually provided by your ISP and has specialized connectors (SC/APC or SC/UPC) for single-mode fiber.
- o Ethernet cable from the ONT to the router's WAN port - This is the cable that connects the Xiaomi router to the converted fiber signal. Most Xiaomi routers do not include the fiber optic cable itself; they include standard Ethernet cables for WAN/LAN connections.

Practical Implications

- o If you are subscribing to fiber internet, your ISP will typically provide the ONT and fiber optic cable. The Xiaomi router will then connect via Ethernet to the ONT.
- o No additional fiber optic cable is usually included in the Xiaomi router box, so you should not expect to plug the fiber line directly into the router without the ONT.
- o Routers like the Be5000 simplify the setup by supporting high-speed WAN ports, eliminating the need for extra converters or switches. In summary, while Xiaomi routers are fiber-ready and capable of handling high-speed fiber connections, the fiber optic cable itself is generally not included; you will need the ISP-provided ONT and Ethernet cable to complete the connection.
