

Which part is the cable tray

A cable tray system consists of side rails, rungs or bottom surfaces, covers, fittings, and support hardware that together form a rigid structure to support and organize cables.

Main Structural Components

- o Splice Plates and Hold-Down Clamps: Secure straight sections together and fasten covers to the tray base .
- o Drop-Outs: Enable cables to exit the tray vertically to connect to equipment below .

Support Hardware

- o Trapeze Hangers, Center-Span Supports, Wall Brackets: These anchor the tray to ceilings, walls, or floors, ensuring stability and proper load distribution .

Types of Cable Trays

- o Ladder Tray: Features side rails and rungs, ideal for heavy power cables and long spans .
 - o Perforated or Ventilated Tray: Has a slotted or perforated bottom for airflow and drainage .
 - o Solid Bottom Tray: Provides maximum protection for sensitive cables against dust, moisture, and EMI .
 - o Basket or Wire Mesh Tray: Lightweight, flexible, and suitable for data or communication cables .
 - o Channel Tray: Narrow and cost-effective, used for supporting one or two cables in compact installations .
