

Which type of socket is best for a distribution box

1. Current and Voltage Ratings Sockets in distribution boxes should match the expected load. Common industrial options include 16A, 32A, 63A, and 125A ratings, with voltage specifications of 220V (single-phase) or 380V (three-phase).
