

Why is there no signal on the router s fiber optic cable

Check Physical Fiber Connections

Use a fiber optic power meter or OTDR to measure signal strength. Values outside the typical range (around -15dBm to -30dBm) indicate signal loss or attenuation . For long-distance connections, consider using optical amplifiers or repeaters to boost signal quality .

Check Router Configuration

Ensure the router is receiving a valid IP address. If the router shows 0.0.0.0, it may not be communicating with the modem or ONT properly . Steps to resolve this include:

- o Reboot the modem/ONT and router in the correct order.
- o Verify the router's WAN port connection.
- o Clone the computer's MAC address to the router if the ISP restricts access.
- o Adjust the router's LAN IP address to avoid conflicts with the modem .

Environmental and Compatibility Factors

Extreme temperatures, moisture, or incompatible fiber components can also cause signal loss . Ensure that all



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fiber components are compatible and properly aligned, and that cables are routed to minimize stress and environmental exposure.

If the above steps do not restore connectivity, contact your ISP or equipment vendor for further assistance.
