

Wiring method for the power distribution box of the sewage pump

One method is to place electrical wires inside a conduit. Running wires through sealed conduit provides physical, water and corrosion protection. Several kinds of conduit are acceptable. A septic pump system uses electrical power to move effluent from a septic tank to a distribution area, such as a drain field or mound system, especially when gravity flow is not possible. Because the pump operates in a wet and corrosive environment, correct wiring is essential for reliable.
