Understanding the Distribution Box

A distribution box (also called a consumer unit, fuse board, or panel board) is the central hub for electricity in a home. It receives power from the utility and distributes it to individual circuits for lighting, outlets, and appliances. Key components include:

- o Connect neutral and ground bars: Attach the neutral wire from the utility to the neutral bar and the ground wire to the ground bar.
- o Install branch circuit breakers: Each breaker corresponds to a specific circuit. Connect the live wire of each circuit to its breaker.
- o Connect neutral and ground wires for each circuit: Ensure proper termination on the respective bars.
- o Check wire gauge and breaker rating: Match wire size to the breaker to prevent overheating.
- o Organize and secure wiring: Use cable ties and maintain neat routing to avoid shorts and facilitate future maintenance .
- o Label circuits: Clearly mark each breaker for easy identification.
