Commissioned by President Emmerson Mnangagwa on Friday, 30 May 2025, the massive US\$88 million structure sits at the junction of three key roads: Simon Mazorodze, Chitungwiza, and High Glen -- all vital arteries for traffic flowing into and out of Harare. After nearly three years of detours, delays, and logistical headaches for transporters and motorists alike, Zimbabwe has officially opened its first-ever multi-level highway interchange -- the Trabablas Interchange, formerly known as the Mbudzi Roundabout. It was official opened on 30 May 2025 by President Emmerson Mnangagwa. The project involves connecting the new interchange with Simon Mazorodze, Chitungwiza and High Glen roads, and is touted as being poised to transform Harare's.
